Place no.	Name	Activities and Vendors' Products
1	Students of ancient craft techniques	Current and already graduated students of ancient craft techniques present different pre-historic work methods from nalbinding to woodwork.
2	Home-brew maker Härkäpää	Manufacture of ancient beer. We show how and from which raw materials the ancient beers are made. During the show, we will tell you old beer stories.
3	Dyers' Guild	Dyeing with nearby plants and colourants. We can also tell you when the first professional dyers settled in Turku.
4	Jewelry maker Emil Lindfors	Jewelry manufacturing by traditional methods by forging, soldering, filing, embossing and stamping. Materials are silver and bronze.
5	Plaque painter	Medieval-style signs and oil paintings. Animals, knights, Vikings and sailboats are the subjects of works on wood and linen.
6	Alnilam (defining time and place)	Presentation of medieval astronomy and the use of hourglasses, sundials, compasses, astrolabs and armillary balls.
7	Antlers and bones	Bones, antlers and horns of different animals are worked on jewelry and utensils.
8	Michal Smolinski (leather work and arrow making)	Leather work and arrow production. Selling leather items, bows and arrows.
9	Re-enactment Society Elävä Keskiaika	Medieval food culture, medieval board games, weaving birchbark, and making mail armour and veil pins.
10	Rumpu-ukko (drums)	Making of drums from reindeer pelt and birch.
11	Yrjänä Ermala (instruments)	Making and selling of musical instruments as well as forged, antler, horn and bone products.
12	Suomen Perinnenahkurit ry (tanners)	The association demonstrates tanning with traditional, ecological and natural methods.
14	Miniature catapult	Shoot a stronghold by a miniature catapult! By knocking down the towers you collect points and with the best result of the week you win a miniature catapult!
15	Medieval painters	Manufacture of paints, varnishes and putties. Painting ornaments and decorative objects as they did in the Middle Ages.
16	Gungnir (medieval goods)	Selling ceramics made according to archaeological finds, historical jewelry and self-made leather goods.

17	Auran Tytöt - Crêpes	We sell crêpes and drinks, and run the carousel at the event.
18	Traditional tanned leather	Demonstrating traditional methods of tanning leather.
19	Quadrex (medieval goods)	Selling bows, arrows and other accessories for archery, leather bags and wooden swords.
20	Three blacksmiths	We forge jewelry and utility items on the spot according to customers' wishes. If there is no commission work, we will do work demonstrations.
21	Medieval carousel	Carousel for the little ones in the family.
22	Odin's Spear (medieval goods)	Selling copies of ceramics, pearls, weapons and knives as well as wooden toys.
23	Clay whistle painting	Clay whistle painting, non-toxic colours. Rooster whistles are made from Finnish red clay. Paints dry quickly.
24	Brother Olav's literacy certificates	Brother Olav tests the literacy of the people and writes literacy certificates every day from 14 to 16.
25	The Guild of St. Ursula	Medieval clothes, woodwork and medicine. Preparation of a saint sculpture by medieval methods.
26	The Guild of Armoursmiths	Tent for guild accessories and combat demonstrations.
27-28	Huovuksissa: sheep and spinning	Sheep, and sheep wool processing to thread with spindle spinning. Carding, spinning and plying. The audience has the opportunity to try spinning with a spindle.
29	Master Juselius' workshop	Here you can embroider and pattern bookmarks and wristbands from leather. In the workshop, we collect two coins (€ 2) for materials.
30	Healer	Body alignment by traditional bone setting methods eases disorders such as neck, shoulder, lower back, sciatica and knee pain.
31	Handicrafts club Käspaikkakerho	Traditional handicrafts: weaving bands and single needle knitting made in Medieval ways.
32	Medieval association Unikankare	Various ribbons and weaving, decoration, ceramics and tapestries are demonstrated.
33	Björk Hus (woodwork)	For sale there are wooden swings, toys and decorations, wool and leather accessories and honey from own bees.

<b>34</b>	Medieval lathe	Lathing with medieval woodturning lathe. Customers can also try turning. Lathed wood products for sale.
<b>35</b>	Cezar (medieval goods)	Selling historical jewelery and toys, leather bottles and various wicker and wood products.
<b>36</b>	Ancient crafts society Ukonvakka	Weaving ribbon, embroidery, nalbinding and chain work.
